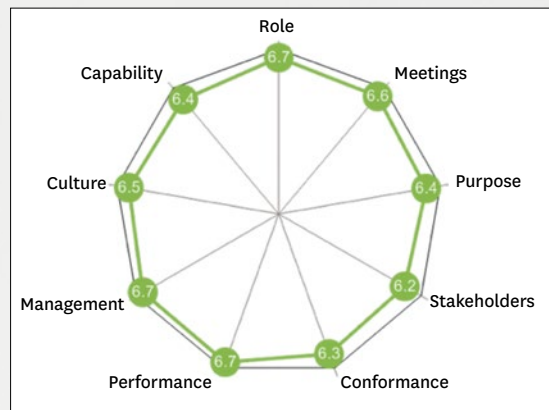


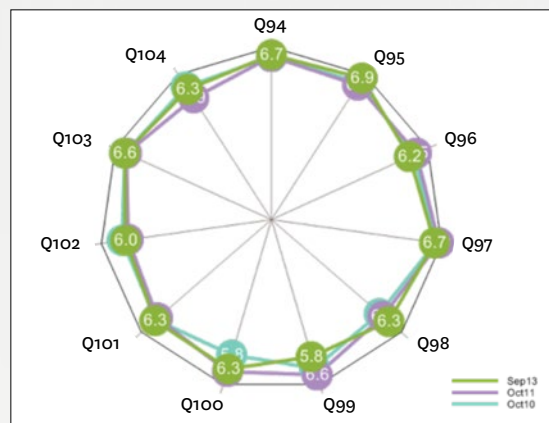
Questionnaire and report formats

Each questionnaire follows a similar format. Questions are grouped into sets under nine areas: role, meetings, purpose, stakeholders, conformance, performance, management and board, culture, and capability.

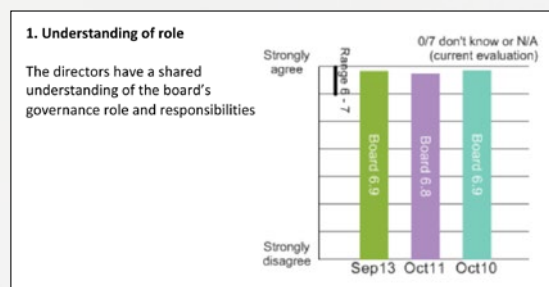
All reports have an Average Rating by Section chart. It gives a simple, graphical representation of areas of strength and weakness over all of the nine areas. ▶



Each set of questions is shown on its own chart and the board's results for the current year can be shown against up to two previous years (as organisations build up their data). That way it's easy to see areas of improvement or slippage. ▶



Results for each individual question are shown including the range of responses, the average of the responses and the number, if any, who answered don't know or N/A. ▶
