

 - for some, costs of trying something new are different




Metro areas lose a bit of heat




Moving to the regions






Globe still reeling

Not as many people heading to restaurants


Annual % change, seated diners at restaurants, 2-week moving average









Annual change






Health & hammers rise

Annual % change




