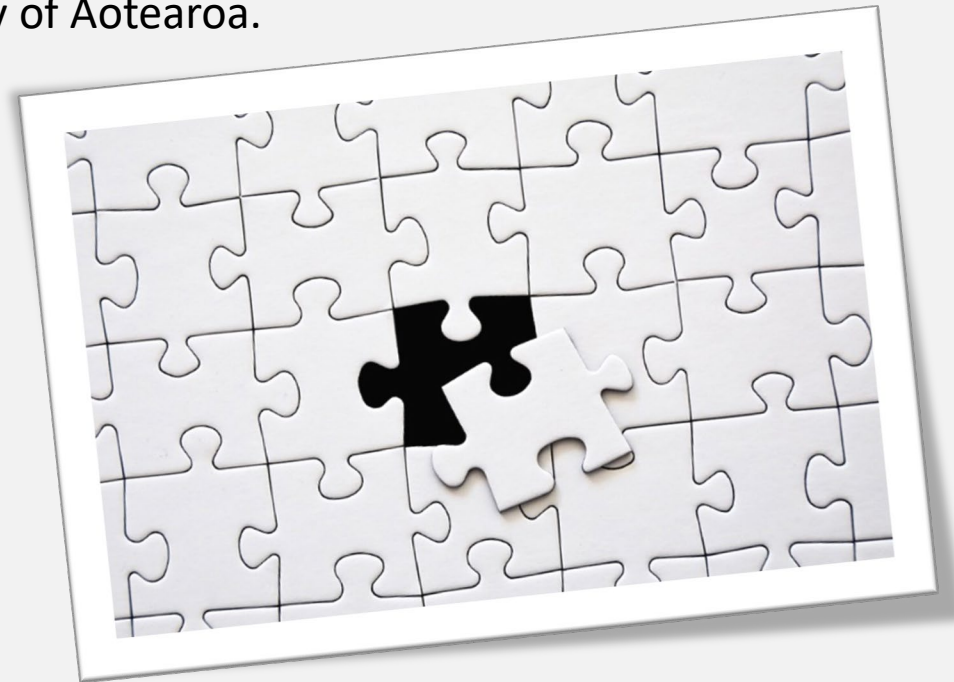


Jigsaw puzzle

Deed of settlement: 1995




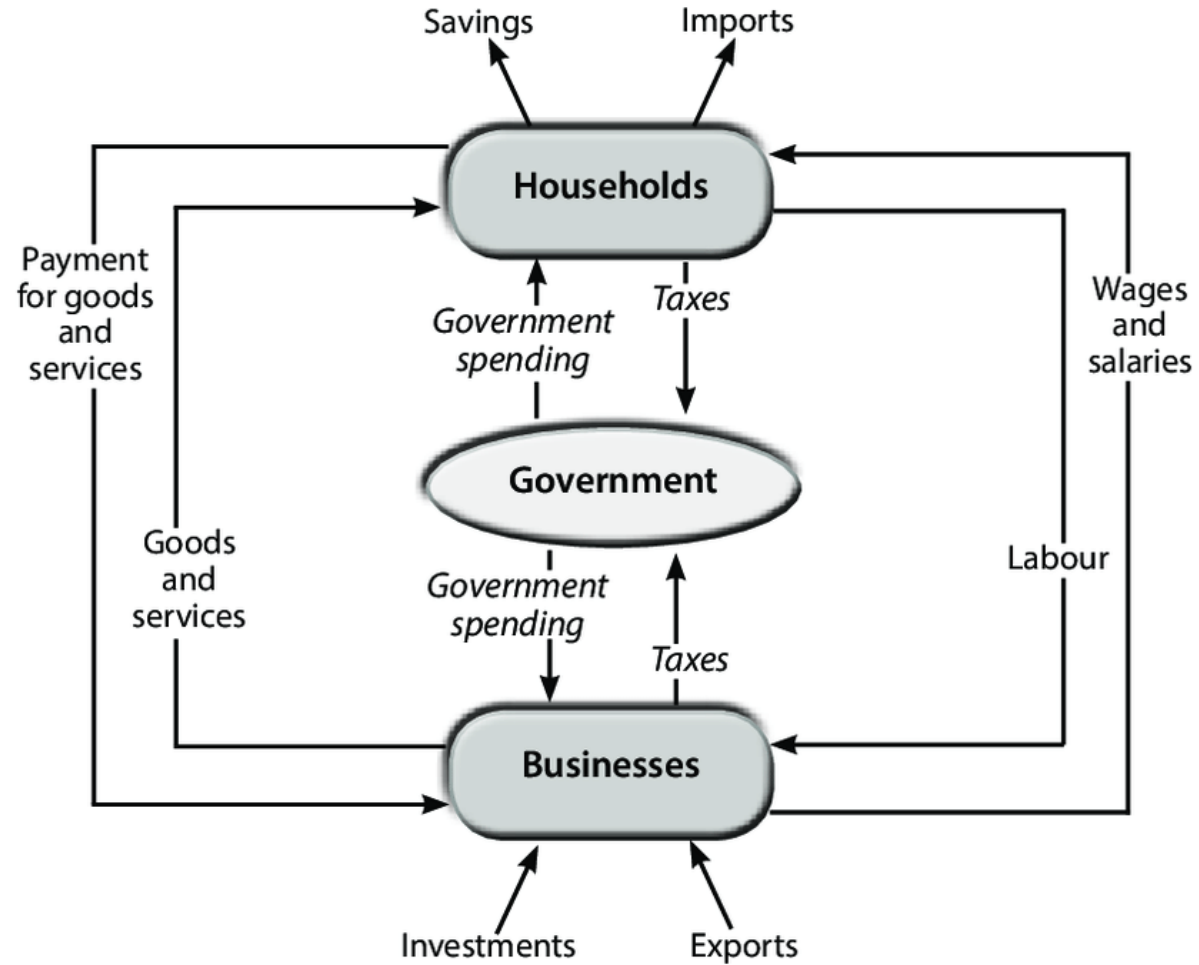

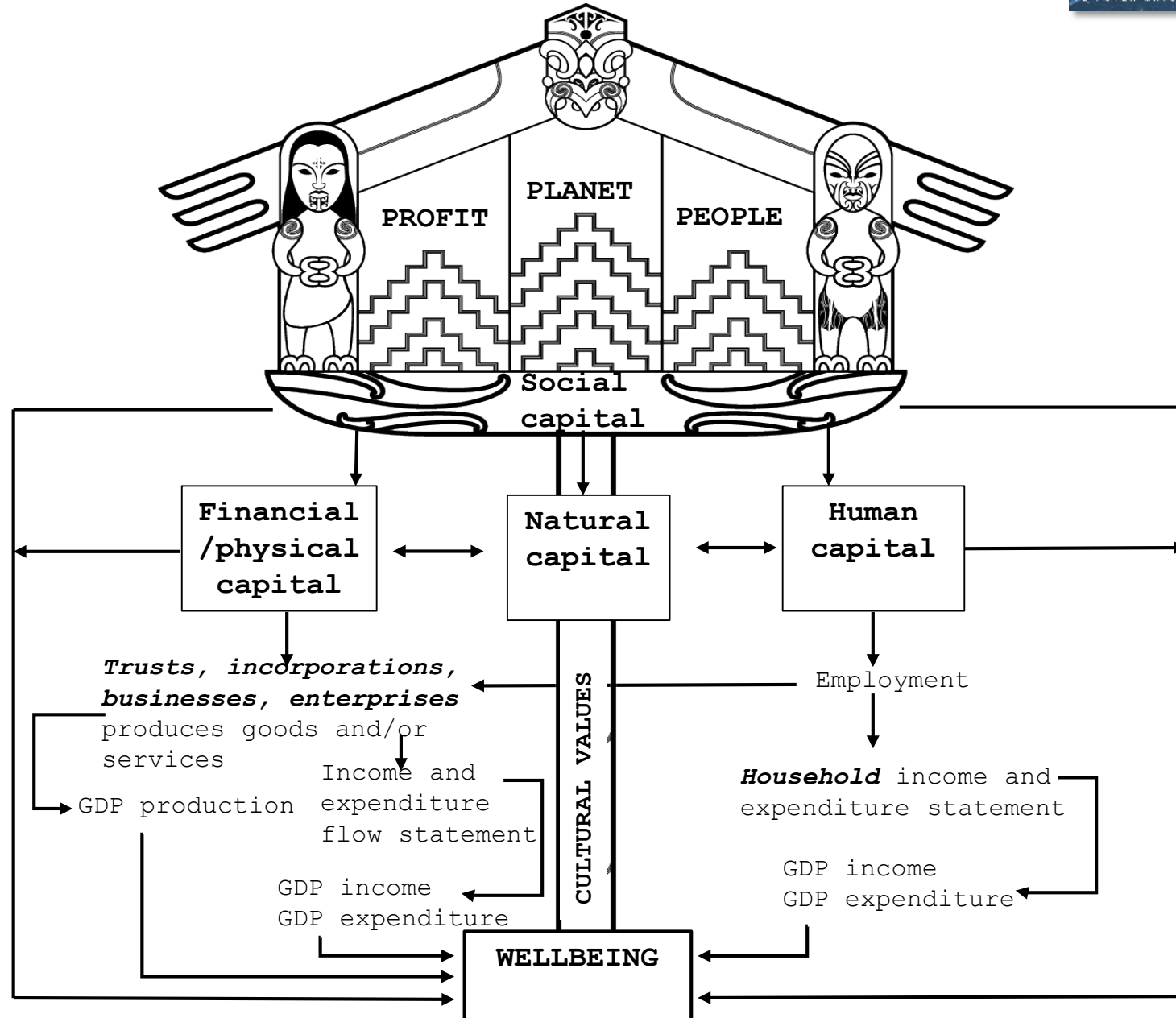


Houston is home to NASA's Johnson Space Center, where some of the world's brightest minds are trying to send man to Mars.

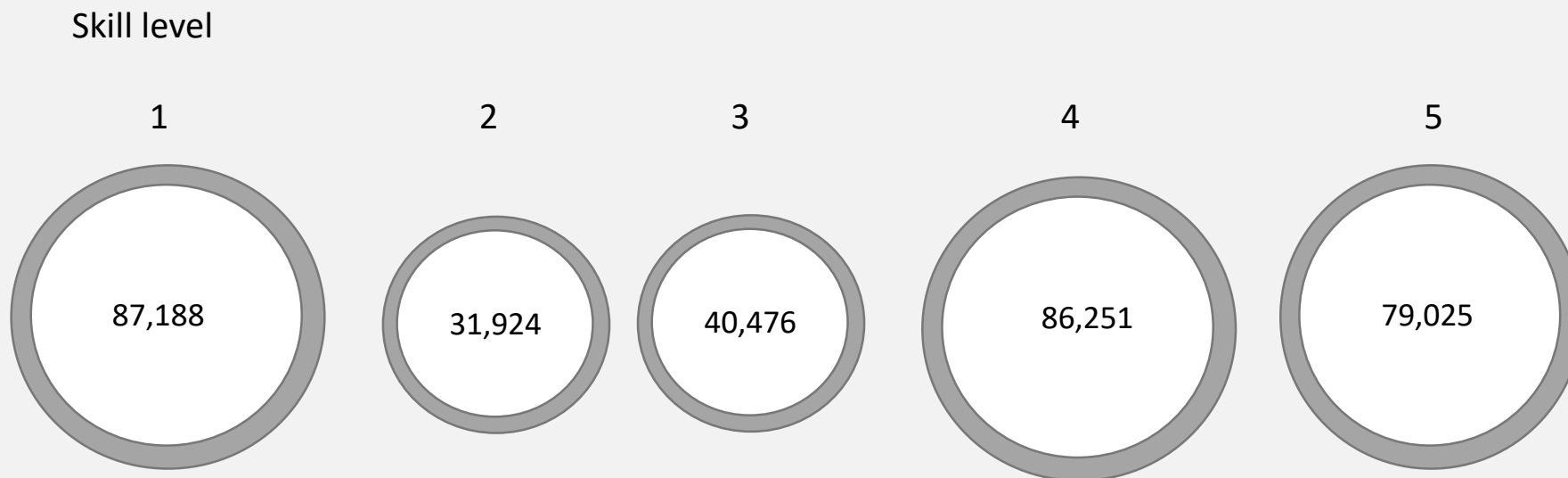

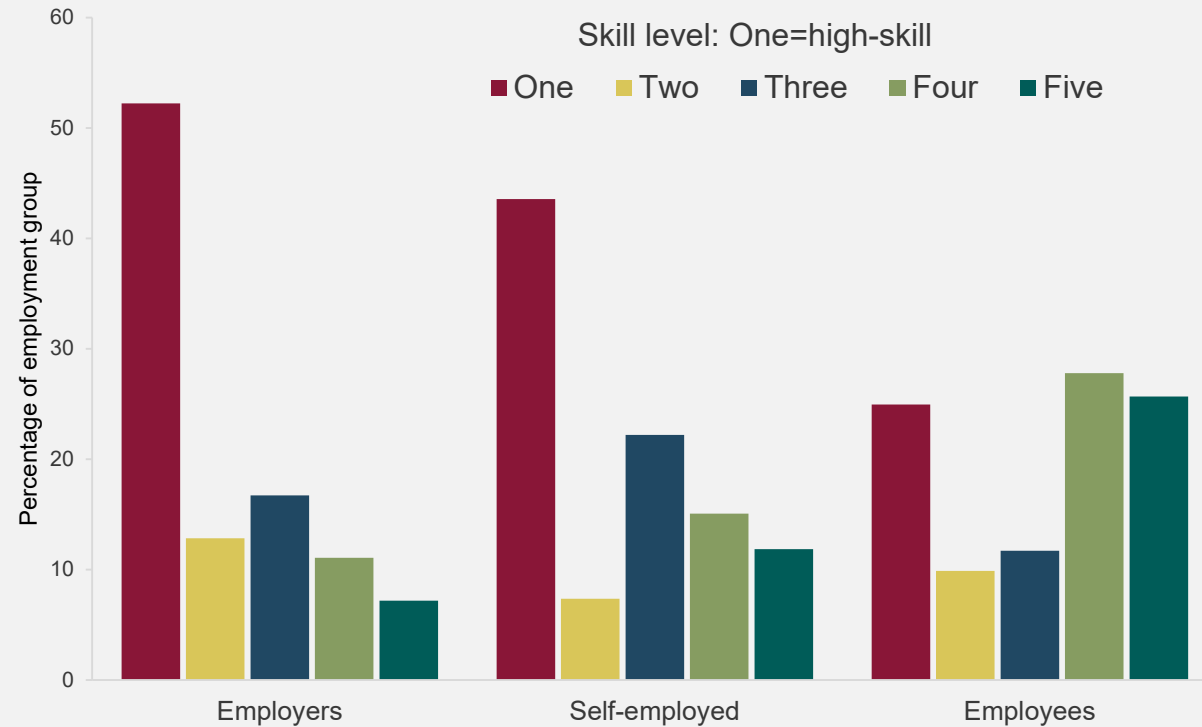
From Census 2013 and 2018

Māori skill level – tale of two halves



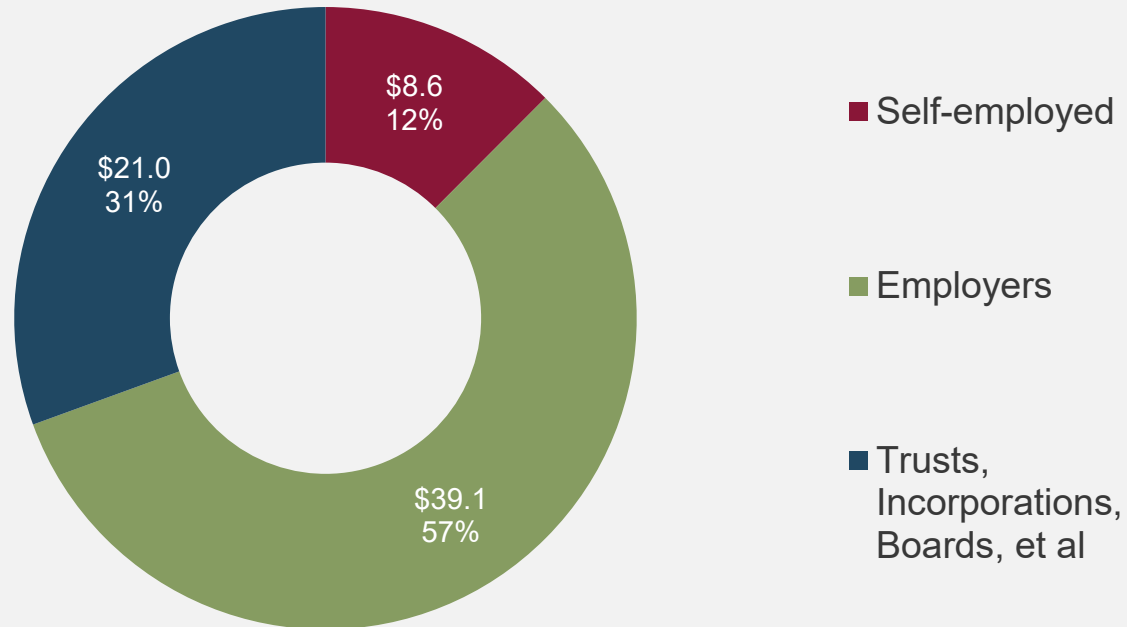
Māori in business – dominated by high skilled category

Skill composition of employed Māori 2018

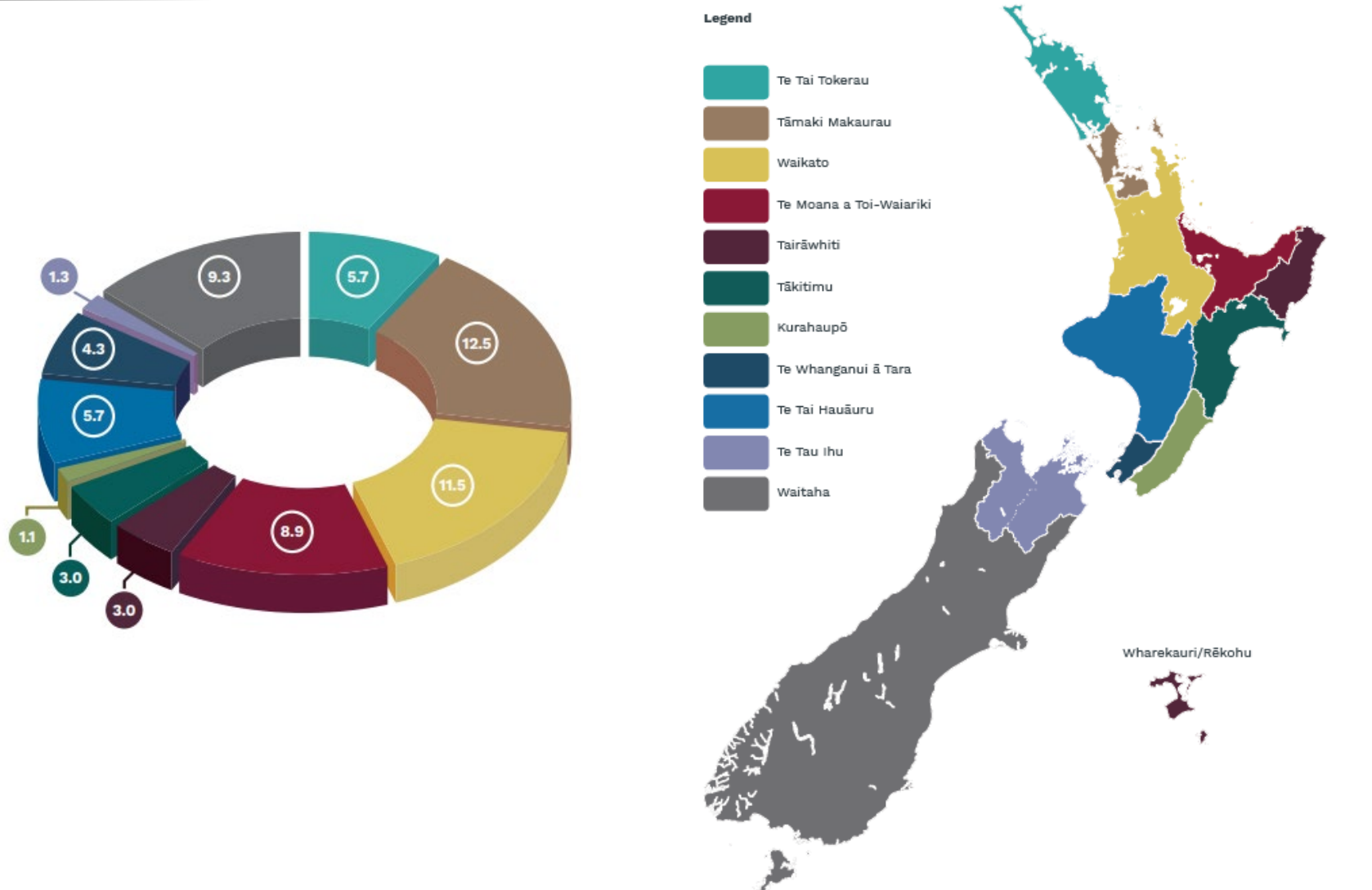


Asset base has grown significantly

In 2018, the financial value of the **asset base totalled \$68.7 billion**

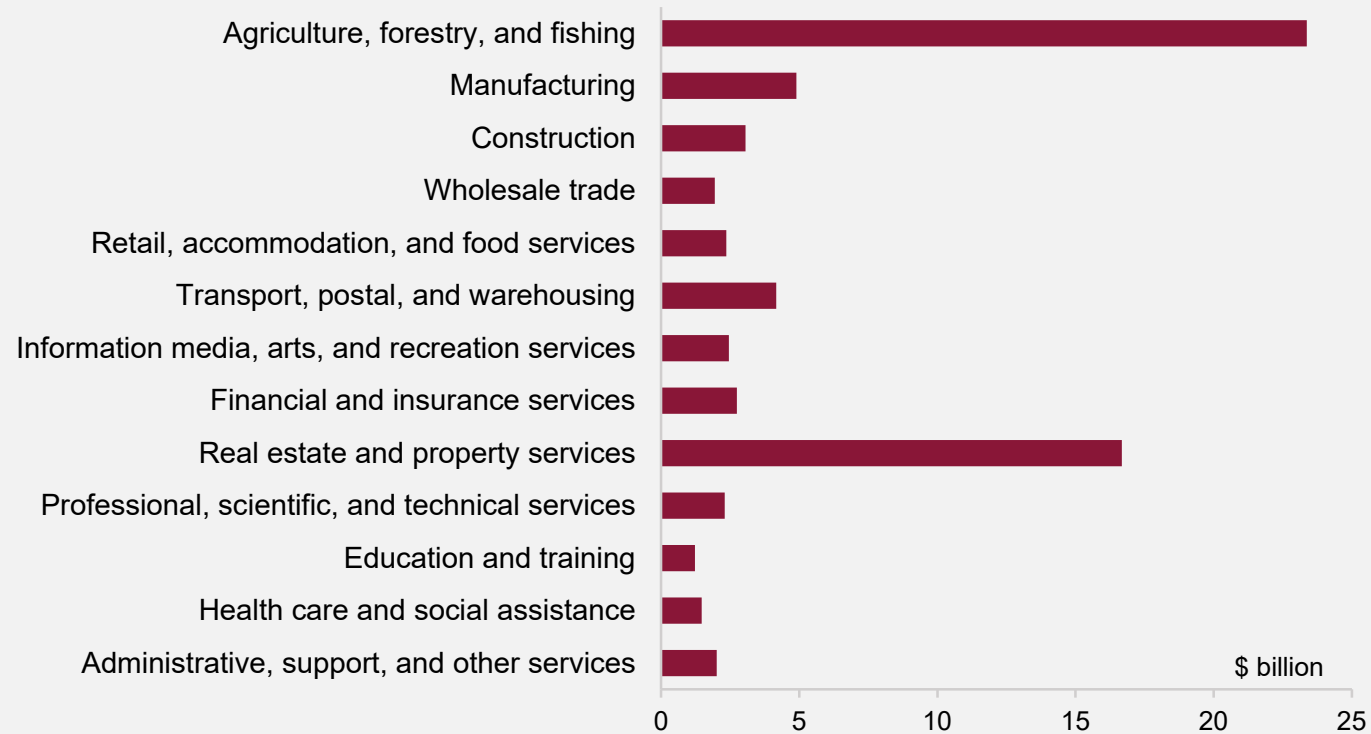


Asset base spread across the rohe



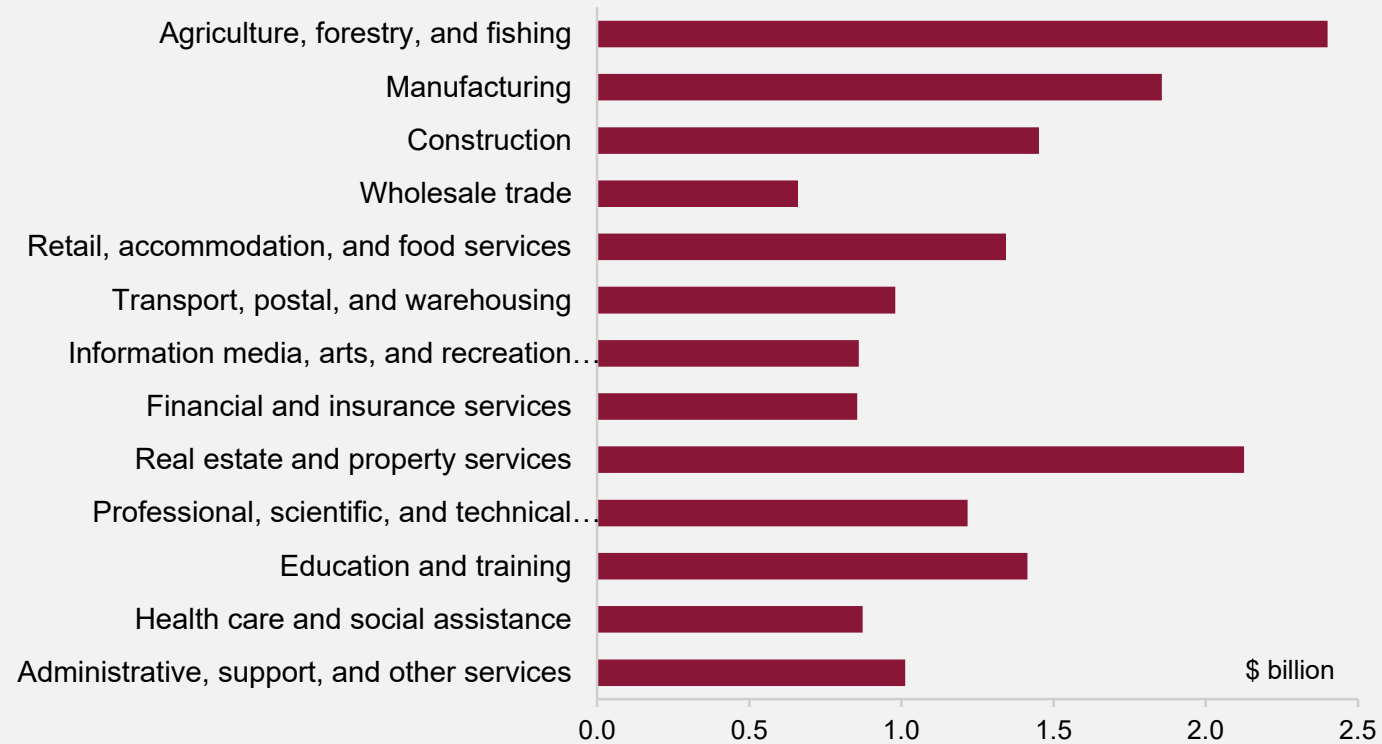
Asset base spread across all sectors

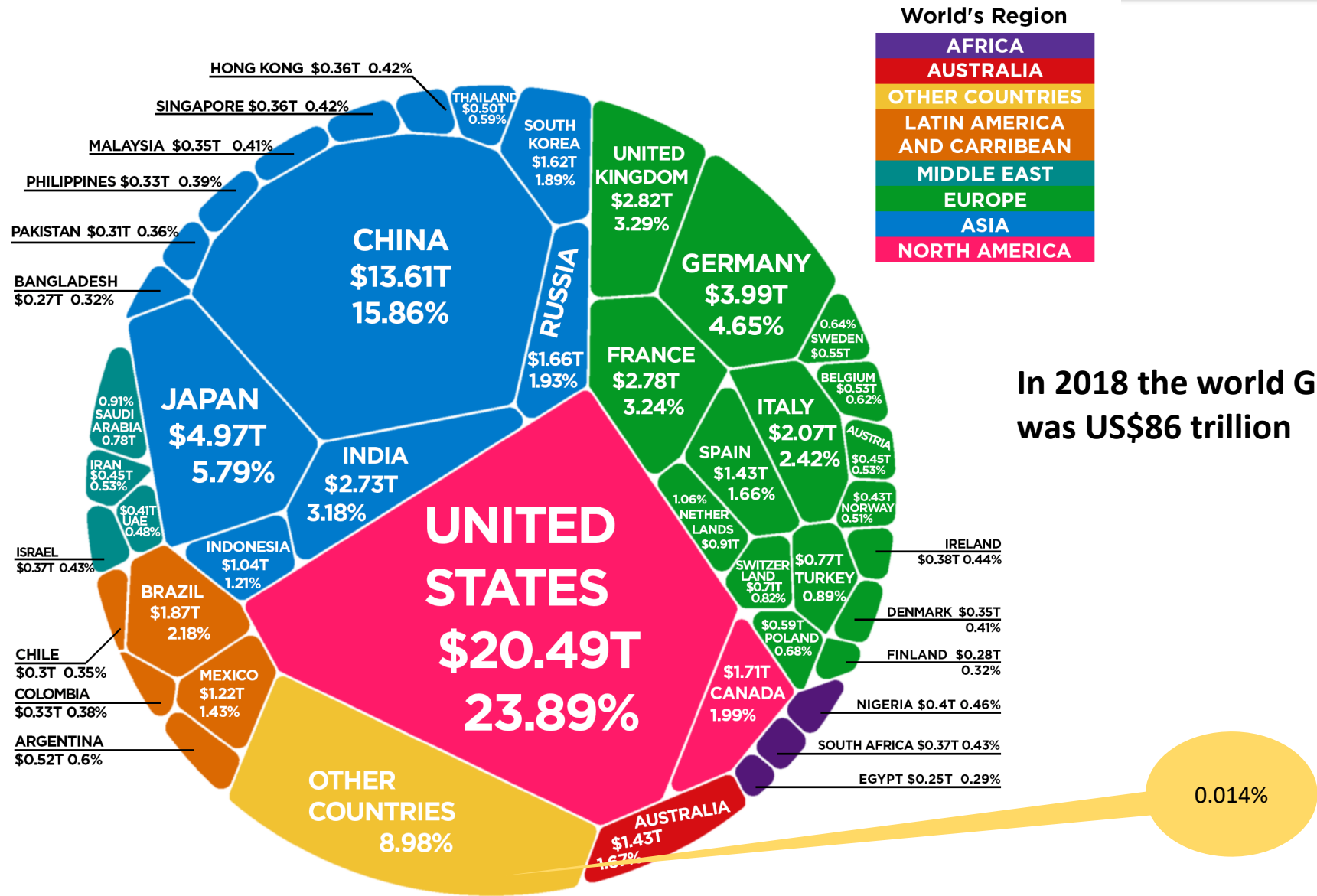
Financial asset base of Te Ōhanga Māori by sector, 2018
